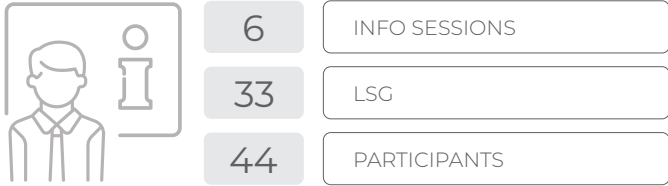

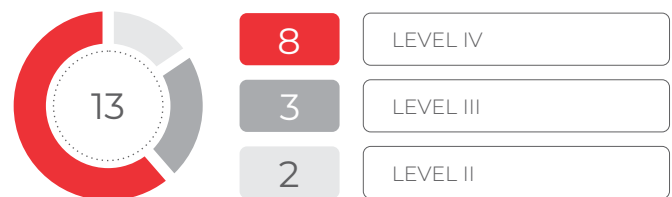

Through the Swiss PRO Programme, the Government of Switzerland supports local governments to establish **Citizens' Advisory Services** aimed at **improving access to the rights of at least 5000 citizens belonging to vulnerable groups**, ensuring their improved social inclusion.

Through this Call for Proposals, LSG receive grants **to establish a standing, systemic and publicly accessible mechanism**, and thereby improve the position of vulnerable social groups at the local level.

He/she will work full time in the municipal administration, while once a week, a field work will be organised in one of the largest local communities (Crvena Reka, Divljana, Koritnica, Klisura and Miranovačka Kula) in order to reach the expected number of 450 beneficiaries.<br><br>NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES: <b>450</b>   |

| 5.  | <b>KNIĆ</b>            | Co-funding<br><b>1,411 EUR</b><br>Swiss PRO<br><b>15,328 EUR</b><br>Total value<br><b>16,739 EUR</b> | A law graduate will work full-time on the following schedule: two days in the municipality building (with access to PWD) and three days on site in the offices of local communities in Gruža, Toponica and Bare, where there is a large concentration of socially vulnerable and elderly population. | 8.  | <b>MEDVEĐA</b>         | Co-funding<br><b>869 EUR</b><br>Swiss PRO<br><b>13,393 EUR</b><br>Total value<br><b>14,262 EUR</b> | A law graduate will work full time at the municipal building and twice a month in various local community offices on their "market day" with the goal of reaching more beneficiaries, especially women and national minorities. The project is planned for 500 beneficiaries.<br><br>NUMBER OF BENEFICIARIES: <b>500</b>   |

It is expected that 600 beneficiaries will benefit from the project implementation. |
