A law graduate will provide services within the existing Service Centre in the municipality, as well as in the five major local communities. It is expected that up to 1200 members of vulnerable groups will use advisory services.

A law graduate will be selected from the register of the National Employment Service (NES). He/she will work full time in the municipal administration, while once a week, a field work will be organised in one of the largest local communities (Crvena Reka, Divljana, Koritnica, Klisura and Miranovačka Kula) in order to reach the expected number of 450 beneficiaries.

The schedule of working hours is also in line with local social events. It is planned that 1000 beneficiaries get the support.
