

The "Enhancing Good Governance and Social Inclusion for Municipal Development" Programme – Swiss PRO" contributes to improving the quality of life of Serbia's citizens, especially vulnerable ones.

Swiss PRO Programme activities include the advancing the rule of law at the local level, strengthening social cohesion and increasing the accountability, transparency, efficiency and effectiveness of local self-governments, as well as civic participation in decision-making processes.

Programme is supported by the Swiss Government in cooperation with the Government of the Republic of Serbia and implemented by the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS) in partnership with the Standing Conference on Towns and Municipalities (SCTM) in 99 towns and municipalities in the Region of Šumadija and Western Serbia and the Region of Southern and Eastern Serbia.
